In order that the competitors listed overleaf to be eligible to compete in this event the following requirements must be met.

Each Competitor Must :

- i) be at least an associate member of **British Gymnastics** and have paid the current year's membership fee. (Competitors from the Home Nations must comply with the requirements of their governing body).
- ii) have registered with the **Competition Registration Secretary** at least 21 days before the date of this competition. (No fee is required to register).
- iii) be eligible to compete at this grade.

The Club Must :-

- i) be registered with **British Gymnastics**.
- ii) have included **full** payment in respect of the entries overleaf including a judging fine if applicable.
- iii) have provided the required number of **suitably qualified** and **experienced** officials (see below).
- iv) **have sent the "Nominated Officials Form" to the Judging events co-ordinator.**

Grades for Double Mini Trampoline Championships

GRADE 1

This is the minimum grade for gymnasts wanting to be selected for Junior and Senior National Teams, Internationals, World Age Games etc. The minimum degree of difficulty is designed to prepare gymnasts for International competition. These minimum requirements will be reviewed on an annual basis.

GRADE 2

This Grade is the start of National Competition for DMT. No double somersaults are allowed in a Grade 2 DMT competition. If a double SS is performed, a Zero DD will be awarded by the Difficulty Judge.

Please note: If you do not fill in the "*official's*" space the competition organiser has the right to refuse entries listed below that space. If any of the officials (or reserve officials) nominated do not turn up for the competition, the club must provide suitably qualified substitutes, failure to do so will result in the club being excluded from the next competition in England or Wales at that Grade.

*The team manager is responsible for the behaviour of his/her club members.
No responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage to property or persons.*

"When submitting entries for a British Gymnastics event the onus is on the club and coaches to ensure that the coaches attending to the participants are qualified to the level of the participants' performance". I can confirm that the above criteria has been adhered to.
