## NATIONAL GRADE '1' & GRADE '2' TRAMPOLINE EVENTS – 2005

<b>Affiliation</b>	<p>The Club must be registered with British Gymnastics and their Regional Gymnastics Association.</p> <p><b>ALL Competitors MUST Members of British Gymnastics.</b></p> <p><b>Associate and competitive membership is due 1<sup>st</sup> October 2004.</b></p> <p><b>Full Membership is due on 1st January 2005.</b></p> <p><i>All Competitors must also register with the Registration Secretary at least 21 days prior to their first event of the season (No fee is required to register).</i></p> <p><b>Registrations by E-mail are acceptable (E-mail registrations must contain all the information on the standard registration form), The Registration Form is available in Microsoft Word, E-mail HOCKENHULLA@aol.com</b></p>

<b>Closing Date</b>	<p>Entries <b>MUST</b> be postmarked <b>on or before</b> the applicable closing date. Should a closing date precede that of a qualifying event arrangements <b>MUST</b> be made with the organiser <b>PRIOR</b> to the closing date.</p> <p>i.e. Entries <b>MUST</b> be sent in with separate cheques to be used or discarded pending the results of the preceding competition.</p>
<b>E-Mails</b>	<p>E-mail entries do not comply with the Rules for entering competitions, a Club may E-mail a list of entries, but the entry form and payment must be sent to the organiser by the closing date. <b>E-mails will not be accepted by the Judging Events Co-ordinator.</b></p> <p><b>DEADLINES</b> are very tight for all competitions. <b>PLEASE</b> help the organisers and send in your entries early whenever possible, be patient and considerate. <b>THANK YOU</b></p>
<b>Age Groups</b> <b>Grade '1'</b>	<p>(Male &amp; Female) U11, U13, U15, U18, 18+, Men's &amp; Ladies. Competitors may only compete Age Group or Men's/Ladies at any Qualifying Event. (Note the exception to this on page 10 of the Competition Structure Booklet)</p>
<b>Age Groups</b> <b>Grade '2'</b>	<p>(Male &amp; Female) U11, U13, U15, U18, 18+</p>
<b>Teams</b>	<p>To consist of 3 or 4 Competitors of the same Age Group &amp; Gender. The highest 3 scores in the first two rounds to count for team total.</p> <p><b>PLEASE NOMINATE TEAM MEMBERS ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.</b></p>
<b>Nominated Judges Form</b>	<p>For Grade 1 &amp; 2 Competitions Clubs must <b>POST</b> the "Nominated Judges Form" to the Judging Events Co-ordinator before the closing date for the competition.</p>
<b>Proof of Posting</b>	<p>All Clubs should obtain Proof of Posting, free from the Post Office, for all "Competition entries", "Nominated Judges Forms" &amp; "Registrations". No queries about late/non arrival of entries will be considered without proof of posting.</p> <p>Please do not send entries by recorded delivery, as this can impede the competition organisation if the organiser needs to collect the entry from the post office.</p>
<b>Rules</b>	<p>All Trampoline Technical Committee Rules apply including all published amendments.</p>
